Before you start... Living on your own or with others? Vacant Units Studio (includes Efficiency/Bachelor - no kitchen) Guest House Apartments (1, 2, 3 Bedroom) Condos Houses Duplexes

Condos are much like an apartment. Include it in your search.

Duplexes are also like apartments. Usually only have 2 units; one on top of the other.

Before you start... Shared Units ✓ Roommate Needed (shared unit) ✓ Room in Private Home ✓ Room for Service

Room in Private Home

Affordable. Some listings include utilities, which saves you money. Flexible lease lengths. If you are graduating early in the academic year or going abroad, a room in private home may give you some flexibility.

Room for Service

Room in exchange for service- tutoring, baby-sitting, household chores. Affordable

Before you start...

n Consider:

- Living in Westwood
 - ▼ Parking Extremely limited space
 - u End of "Apron" parking Enforcement started June 2007
 - ▼ Parking on campus <u>www.transportation.ucla.edu</u>
- Living a few miles away
 - Better street parking
 - ∨ Public Transit
 - BruinGo Flash Pass \$22.50/Qtr or \$.25 a ride! For Big Blue Bus, Culver City
 - Go Metro! Metro Buses, Metro Rail
- Non-Resident Meal Plan (purchase quarterly)

Consider:

Location and cost vs. amenities

Drive or walk neighborhood – are you comfortable?

Learn lease terms – 6 or 12 months, "month to month"

For example, Westwood:

Availability- parking on campus is tough to get

Before you start...

- n Move-in Date
 - Know when you want to move-in
 - √ In general
 - □ Intent to Vacate − 1 month notice to landlords
 - **a** Seriously search 4 − 6 weeks in advance of move-in date
 - ✓ Westwood
 - **u** Call or Visit buildings for up-coming availability
 - <u>a</u> Beware of wait lists read the fine print!

Getting on a wait list may require you to sign documents that will bind you to the apartment if it is offered to you.

This means getting on multiple wait lists could bind you to multiple apartments.

Be sure to ask to view the room you will be signing the lease for. NO SHOWROOMS!

- UCLA Housing Rental Verification 24 hr. return

 - ▼ Google Maps Coming Soon!
 - Students post for free!
 - √ 30-day listing
 - ▼ Roommate Needed
 - ▼ Shared or Vacant Sublet
 - ▼ Roommate Available
 - ▼ Tenant Available NEW! Currently seeking vacant unit

You can edit your listing within the 30 day period

Once it expires you can renew it for free!

- n What else can I do?
 - Network!
 - ▼ Tell everyone you know what you are looking for. Everyone is a potential lead.
 - Visit your desired neighborhood in person
 Look for posted signs
 - Be diligent
 - Try to check out new listings as soon as you see them.

- n Make the call!
 - Schedule an appointment to view the unit
 - Tip: A local phone number is helpful
 - When you view the unit ask questions
 - ▼Any utilities included?
 - **▼** Noise complaints?
 - ∨ Length unit has been empty?
 - ▼ Is parking available with the unit?
 - ▼ How many other people have viewed the unit?

- n Application and Credit Check
- n Signing the lease READ CAREFULLY!
- n Deposit
